DESCRIPTION

CREW CARE Dishwasher Detergent is a concentrated liquid alkaline, non-foaming dish/utensil detergent meant for use in galleys' automatic dishwashers. CREW CARE Dishwasher Detergent is highly effective in removing starch, protein, fats, and oils. It is recommended for use in automatic dishwashers found in food service and food handling areas in galleys. As part of hygienic work practices, CREW CARE Dishwasher Detergent is recommended to remove foodstuffs and fats during automatic dishwashing.

APPLICATION & USE

For dishwashers, the product can be fed directly from the container into the dishwasher via the auto dispensing system in the automatic dishwasher. Product can also be manually added to dishwasher just prior to washing. About 8 mL is required per load (about one capful). Safe on aluminum when used as directed.

PACKAGING

CREW CARE Dishwasher Detergent is part of CREW CARE module, CREW CARE QL-25, PCN 1AB3449.

CREW CARE Dishwasher Detergent also has limited availability as a standalone purchase, delivered in a case of 2 x 2.5 gallon (approximately 2 x 9.5 L) containers (PCN 1AB3454).

As part of the CREW CARE Program, the products and containers are color and number coded for ease of use on board ensuring the right product is used for the right application.
